General Rules

- Golf carts are designated for <u>show staff use only</u>. Vehicles will be provided to assist individuals with disabilities.
- Truck and trailer parking is located on the south of the main roundabout entrance.
 After unloading, vehicles may be driven to the Show Field entrance using the main entrance roundabout.
- Spectator parking is available in the west and north parking lots.
- Use only Gate 2 and 3 entrances at Wicks Field for concessions and restrooms.
- The DJ will play music, make announcements, and announce door prize winners every 10-15 minutes.
- Grilling or cooking is not allowed in the Show Field or parking lot areas.
- Kindly refrain from relocating cones or barricades, as they are placed to restrict access by unauthorized vehicles during the event.

Show Participants

- Upon arrival at the show field, participants pay the registration fee and receive a numbered ticket, which serves as the door prize number. The ticket should be retained to claim the door prize if selected.
- Subsequently, you will be escorted to a designated area where your vehicle will be photographed, and you will receive a Registration Package.
- After your photo, you'll be directed to a parking spot in the Show Field. Car show entries use the east lot; spectators use the west and north lots.
- After parking, complete the Registration Form, Dash Card, and the top of the Judging
 Form from your package. Take them to the Registration Tent at the north end of Wicks
 Field's show area. If you're unsure about your vehicle category or don't want to be
 judged, inform the Registration Tent staff and they will assist you.
- After registration, place the Dash Card and Judging Form on your dashboard so judges can easily see them.
- Prepare your vehicle for judging. Judging begins at 9am with early entries and ends at noon. You don't need to be present. Keep your hood and trunk open, and convertible top up.
- After evaluation, judges place a green sticker on the dash card to indicate judging is finished.
- Explore the show field and connect with participants. Music begins at 9AM. **Restrooms and food are inside gates 2 and 3 of the stadium.** Visit sponsor booths during your stay.
- Winners receive awards and trophies at 1 PM.
- Show vehicles must leave the Show Field by 4pm.
- First 125 registered vehicles receive goody bags.
- Vehicles awarded a grand prize, such as Best of Show, cannot win class awards.

NAR-AACA 2025 SHOW CAR CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES

Each vehicle is assigned to the class that best matches its current condition and level of originality or modification. Judges may inspect cars during registration to ensure correct classification and show officials can provide clarification if needed. Vehicles not meeting class criteria may be reassigned before judging to maintain fairness and consistency among all entries.

- 1. The 2025 show class list was based on 2023 participation data, with extra classes added to reduce those with over 15 cars.
- 2. If unsure about your car's class, refer to these guidelines:
 - A. A vehicle may not be registered in more than one class. For example, an original 1964 Mustang is not eligible for registration in both the Factory Correct Mustang 1964-1970 class and the Survivor thru 1969 class.
 - B. Factory Correct Class includes cars and trucks that are original but may have up to two visible modifications, such as chrome valve covers or an aftermarket air cleaner, each counting as one modification.
 - C. The Modified Class is for cars or trucks with three or more modifications (such as external, engine, wheels, suspension, interior). If a modified vehicle is entered in the Factory Correct class, authenticity points will be forfeited on the judging sheet.
 - D. The Survivor Class applies to vehicles that remain as originally manufactured, without modifications or restorations. One repaint in the original color is permitted.
 - E. The Foreign Vehicles class includes all vehicles manufactured outside of the country, such as VW, Porsche, and Audi. Asian-made vehicles are entered in the Foreign Vehicle - Asian class, while European-made vehicles are entered in the Foreign Vehicle - European class.
 - F. Project Class includes vehicles that are works-in-progress and may not be operational.
 - G. The AACA National Award Winner designation applies to vehicles that have previously received an AACA Nationals Winner Badge.
 - H. The motorcycle class applies to all registered motorcycles.

Classes may be changed on the day of the show depending on attendance. Additional classes may be added if certain classes have too many participants or if there are unexpected arrivals.






